It creates the enthusiasm that opens the door to exploration and learning - **Be Curious**;

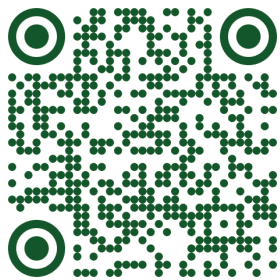
It translates the pride in our work to care for others' experiences - **We Care**;
