Why am I no longer receiving my monthly inventory report via email?

The automated monthly inventory report, a valuable tool suggested by James Armand, was discontinued with the removal of the Cognos reporting system.

However, you can easily replicate this functionality. You can now schedule the "Power BI inventory coordinator report" on-line to be delivered to your email monthly.

Maintaining your inventory throughout the year, as opposed to waiting until the last few weeks before the annual inventory is due, is part of our standard policy and makes the annual process significantly easier and less prone to errors. Regularly monitoring your inventory ensures you consistently know what assets you have and their current locations.
